The Clothing Shop: The Clothing Shop serves over 5,000 clients every month. Clothing is given free to Waukesha County residents in need. We accept men, women, and children's clothing in good clean condition without any holes, rips, stains or tears. Our most critical current needs include:

- Men's XXL and up in season clothing
- Men's jackets
- Men's new underwear/boxers sizes: 28 - 38
- Men's new ankle and crew socks
- Girl's & Boys clothing all sizes
- Girl's new underwear sizes: 4, 6, 12, 14, & 16
- Boy's new underwear sizes: 2, 4, 6, 8, & 14
- Ladies new ankle and crew socks
- Ladies new bikini style underwear sizes: 5, 6, & 7

Financial Assistance: We are able to help clients in crisis situations with gas cards or bus passes to get to work
